This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of <u>14.959 mills</u>, an increase of <u>2.407</u> mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than <u>12.552</u> mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of <u>\$100,000</u> is approximately \$<u>91.47</u> and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of <u>\$75,000</u> is approximately <u>\$72.21</u>.
